Take a shoe box and fill it with the toiletries from the list below. Be creative - feel free to decorate your box, use these graphics or any others. Include a note of cheer and/or some Easter candy! Completed kits should be brought to Shoebox by Friday, March 26th, so they can be delivered to a shelter prior to Easter.

Fill a large shoebox with:

- 1 magazine
- 1 months women's feminine hygiene
- 1 full-size bottle of shampoo
- 1 full-size hair conditioner
- 1 can of shaving cream
- 1 large tube toothpaste
- 2 adult toothbrushes
- 2 child's toothbrushes
- 1 woman's deodorant
- 1 man's deodorant
- 1 bar soap in ziplock bag
- 1 comb or hair brush
- 4 individual band-aids
- 3 disposable razors
- 1 full-size lotion
- 1 pocket-size tissues
- 1 pair woman's socks
- 1 pair man's socks
- 1 packet of laundry soap
- 1 mending/sewing kit
- 1 washcloth

Vary ingredients accordingly
for a family, man or woman.
